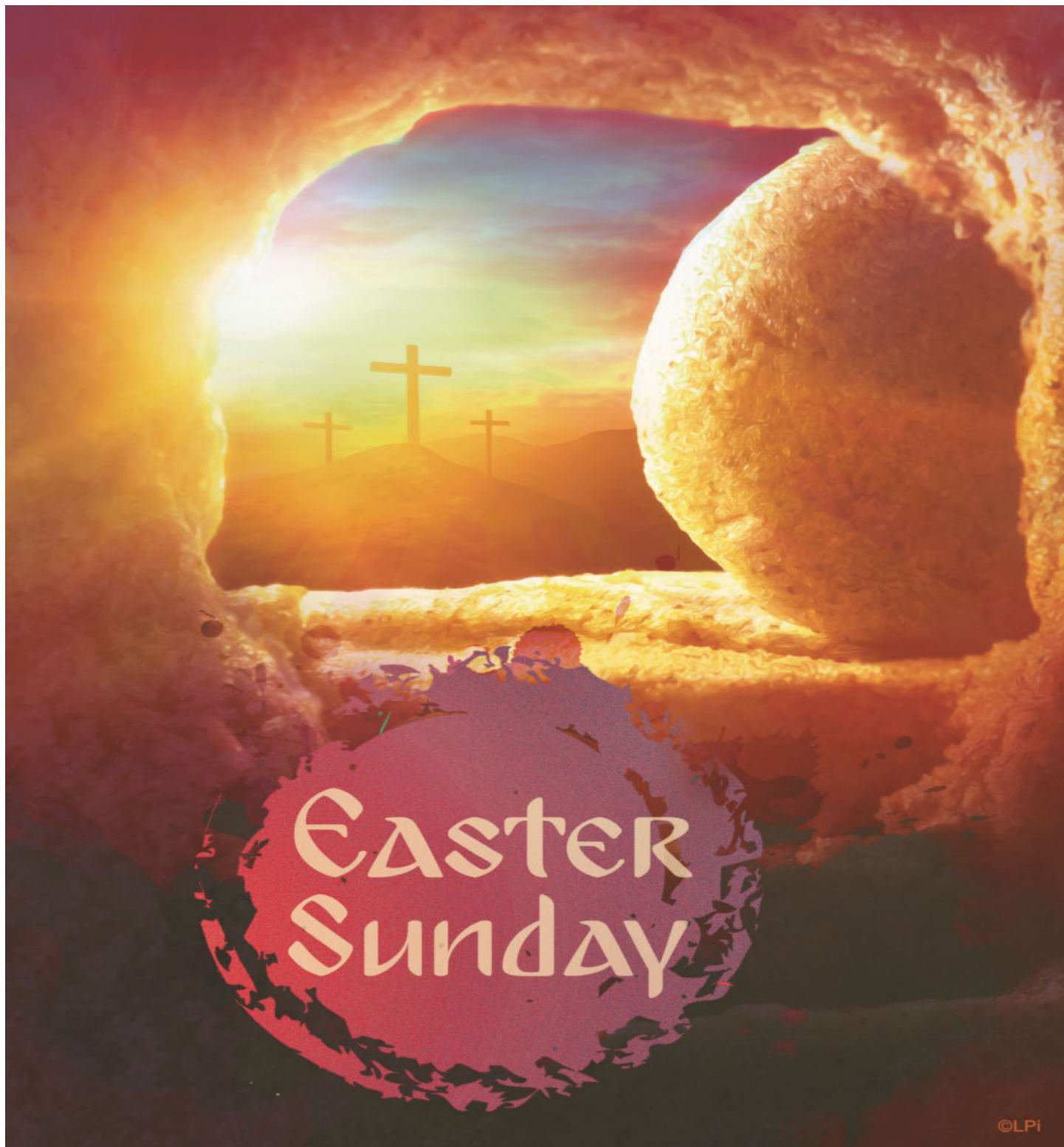

A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family of Our Lady at St. Germaine,

After his resurrection on Easter Sunday morning Jesus appeared to his disciples in Jerusalem. Christ “broke bread” with them; he had breakfast with them, and they recognized that the Risen Lord was in their presence. Their eyes were opened their hearts were once again burning with Christ’s love and they were filled with his peace.

They were also promised never to be alone, that Christ would always be with them in the “breaking of the bread,” in the Eucharist. They would also be filled with the gifts of the Holy Spirit that they would be able continue the mission of proclaiming his kingdom of peace and hope until he came again in glory.

Each time we gather at the Eucharistic Table; we celebrate the resurrection of Christ. Gathered around the Lord’s Table, we look forward, with hope, to the day we rejoice with Christ. We anticipate singing alleluia at the table of eternal life in the kingdom of heaven with the choir of angels and the communion of saints.

Then as we go in the Lord’s Peace from His Table to gather at table with our family and friends to celebrate Easter breakfast or supper, we share with each other the peace of our Risen Lord, looking forward to sharing in his perfect and eternal peace and eternal light symbolized by the Paschal Candle, the Easter Candle.

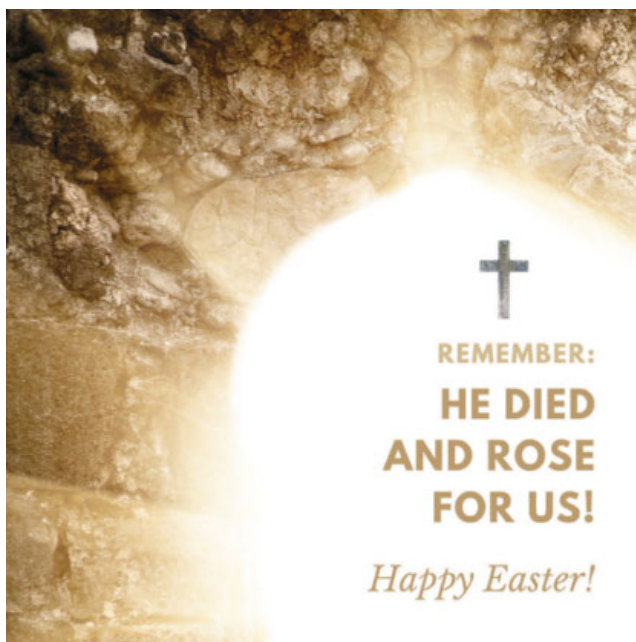
But we also know well that the kingdom is not yet fully present in all homes or at all tables. There is still much darkness that the light of Christ must outshine. The world is constantly in need of healing, reconciliation, and the light of Christ to guide it out of darkness to the light of Christ’s peace.

We are that light, created in the image of God, restored to that image by Christ’s death on the Cross and his Resurrection, that we share in through the waters of baptism. We are reflections of Christ’s compassion, mercy, and love that must continue to proclaim Christ as our Savior who makes a difference in our lives and through us a difference in our world.

May God Bless us, fill us with hope, peace, and the light of our Risen Savior as we gather at the Eucharistic Table of the Lord, and at table with our families, friends, and neighbors.

What is Eucharistic Adoration? Adoration is a Eucharistic devotion whereby members of the parish unite on taking an hour of adoration before the Most Blessed Sacrament for 1 hour of each week. We would like to invite you to become an adorer, one who spends an hour before the Blessed Sacrament. The Most Blessed Sacrament is exposed in a special vessel called a monstrance, which comes from the Latin word, monstrance, meaning "to show". (Persons who dedicate at least an hour weekly are called adorers and they form the backbone of Adoration)



If you would like to be a Substitute Adorer or you would be willing to be an adorer on a different day -

Monday or Friday we would love to hear from you so that if we got enough response we could open another day in the Adoration Chapel.

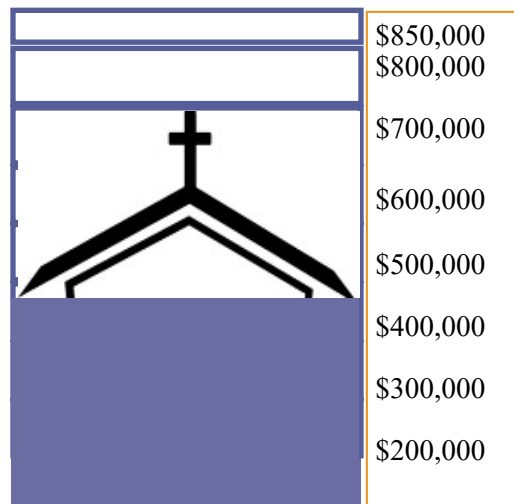
