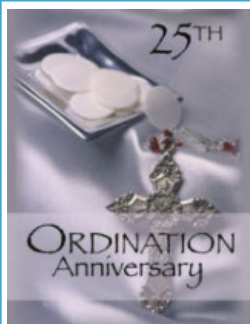


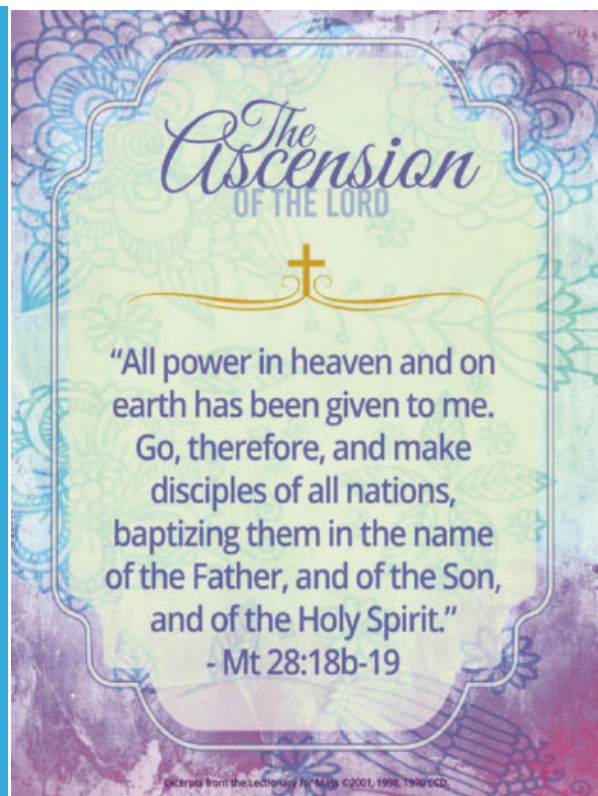


Congratulations Father John T. Noga 25 Year Silver Jubilee

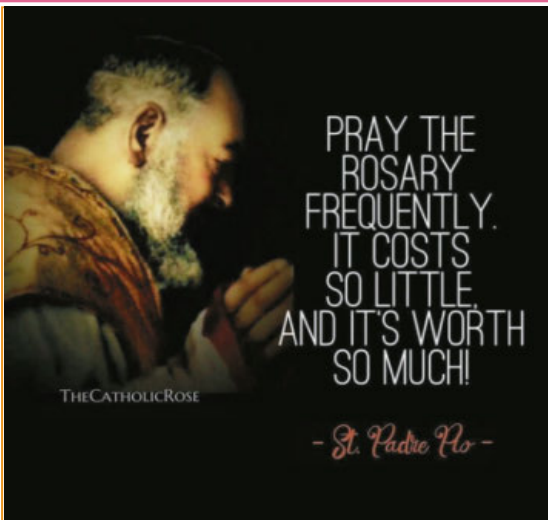

CATHOLIC CHARITIES HELP THE HUNGRY AND HOMELESS

In the South and Southwest areas **each month** 3200 individuals from the Southwest suburbs receive their basic food supply from the St. Blasé Food Pantry and an additional 2500 individuals are served through the food pantry at St. Irenaeus. 80 otherwise homeless families are housed in the New Hope Apartments and other transitional housing intended to get families to become independent. Over 200 veteran's families (304 individuals) were assisted through 141 units of permanent housing and other services. Veterans come into the program literally homeless or at risk of losing their homes. These are men and women who have served our country. The hot meal program which served more than 8,500 meals to the hungry and the homeless in the South and Southwest areas is now a carryout program serving about 5,200 individuals. Many of those served are our neighbors. In addition to those served above, 48 families, 84 individuals from Oak Lawn and the surrounding area have received direct emergency assistance throughout the year.

The Mother's Day Collection for Catholic Charities is this weekend, May 11-12. Those of you who get Church donation envelopes in the mail will find a special envelope for Catholic Charities. Those who attend weekend Masses at St. Germaine can take one of the Catholic Charities envelopes that you will find at the three exits. Please help us fight hunger and homelessness in the South and Southwest area by donating to the Catholic Charities Mother's Day Collection.

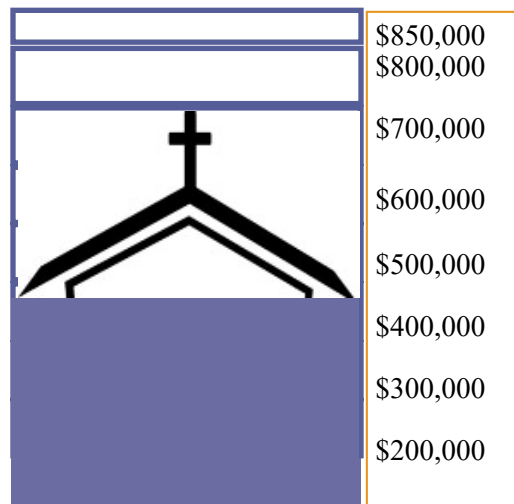

What: Ministers of Care bring the Eucharist to Catholics from all walks of life who are unable to participate in the Eucharistic Liturgy at their parishes. Recipients may include Catholics who are home bound, residing in nursing homes, or patients in hospitals. The Archdiocese conducts periodic training to help insure those called to ministry are educated in the spirituality, theology, and the rites of Pastoral Care of the Sick. This training also insures people are properly prepared to participate in this important ministry.

A FREE Copy of the "Minsters Of Care" Book will be provided to each participant in the training.

Who: Parishioners, Men and Women 18 years of age and older, with support from their local Pastor. *It is important to let your Pastor*, and the Minister of Care Coordinator from your Parish, know of your desire to attend the training. (Your Pastor will request you be mandated for service after we verify completion of the training.)

Topics to be covered: Spirituality of the Minister Experience of Suffering, Pastoral Listening Skills Theology of Suffering and Sickness, Ministerial Procedures Prayer and Sacraments, Other Considerations

Participation is limited to the first 35 people to enroll. There is **no cost** for the training. However, a "Free Will Donation" can be made during check-in to offset some of the costs. Your generosity is greatly appreciated.

The Eucharist is the source and summit of our Catholic faith.

HAVE YOU TRIED THE MANNA PROGRAM?

The Manna Program is one of the school's most successful fundraisers. Families that participate purchase gift cards from local vendors who rebate a portion of the purchase price to the school. For example, if a family purchases a \$100 Jewel card, they receive the full \$100. Jewel rebates about 4% to the school (\$4.00). So that rebate of 4% then gets split between the school and the family. That can be used for tuition for School, Religious Education or high school tuition. ***Even if you try using it for groceries and gas, it would help out!*** The beauty of the program is that it provides "free money" from sources outside of the parish with no extra expenses to anyone. During the 2022-2023 school year, the total rebates from all vendors was \$25,860.00.



Manna certificates are sold weekdays in the school office. The program is open to everyone in the parish and provides a huge support to the school budget. For more information, contact the school office at 708-425-6063.
